

ACCOMODATION

RULES AND REGULATION

Please note that the following rules are to be followed by every participant residing within the campus. No exemptions of any kind would be entertained and handling of particular cases is entirely up to the Tamasha'10 Host Team's discretion.

1. Participants shall be staying in the allotted common rooms.
2. Participants are prohibited from using irons in the rooms.
3. Kitchen and laundry services will not be available for the participants in the hostel.
4. Participants are to keep their respective rooms clean at all times.
5. In case of a problem, participants are to contact their respective class rooms volunteer.
6. Participants are to cooperate with the volunteers.
7. Each participant is expected to take care of his/her mattress and would be held responsible for spillage, destruction or misplacement of the mattress.
8. The participant would be liable for penalty, depending on the damage done.
9. Any participant/s responsible for the damage or destruction of items in the common room will be severely penalized.
9. Damage to the room walls by participants will be penalized.
10. Smoking is strictly prohibited in the rooms. Any participant doing so shall be heavily penalized according to the Tamasha'10 Policy.
11. Possession or usage of alcohol, drugs, or any intoxicants is strictly prohibited.
12. Loud music or excessive noise of any kind is discouraged.
13. Please ensure that all your belongings are locked in your suitcases, and safely put away while you are out of common room or room. The Host Team is not responsible in any way for any theft or misplacement.
14. Please ensure that you ONLY use the washrooms assigned to the Tamasha participants' use. Participants are liable to be penalized for not following the system.
15. Participants are advised to follow a moral and ethical code of conduct at all times. Use of foul language, picking a fight, abusing or harassing fellow-participants or indulging in any offensive behavior can result in immediate expulsion.
16. Participants are not allowed to leave the campus before the issue of their respective

participant identification tag, which will be issued on the day of registrations.

18. The penalty\punishment will be decided on a case to case basis and is entirely up to the discretion of the Tamasha '10 Host Team. The decision made by the Host Team shall stand final and there will be no contestation or challenge to that decision.
